On the above date and approximate time, I (Spells) spoke with reporter Andalib Khelghati (District 65 Assistant Superintendent) who explained that he was notified by District 65 Superintendent (Dr. Devon Horton) on 08/10/20 that he as well as District 65 school board members had received ten (10) emails between 08/06/20 - 08/08/20 in regards to a recent decision he made involving school services to minority students. According to Khelghati, Dr. Horton and other School Board Members shared concerns about the emails and requested that they be reported and subsequently investigated.

Re the discrimination directed against children who look like you by Black Supremacists superintendent Devon Horton and deputy superintendent Latarsha Green, as described via the national media link and Evanston media reference below:

"We are in a pandemic." Horton said. according to a report from the Evanston RoundTable on Tuesday.... But there was a pandemic before this.... That was inequity and racism, and classism and all of these other things (emphasis added, to point out the intellectual depth of Devon`s hate). Latarsha Green said the prioritized categories include "students receiving free or reduced lunch, Black and Brown students, students who received an I [Incomplete] or less than 50% on their report cards, (emphasis added, to point out the depth of Latarsha`s hate in giving Black, token brown and (black) failing students preferences over your achieving (Asian) students), emerging bilinguals, and students with IEPs. (Parentheses added to show the real hate-filled and Black Supremacist agenda).

So, [REDACTED], if I understand Devon`s and Latarsha`s progressive hate, kids who have melanin content like yours aren`t welcome in District 65, and if they are already there, to the irritation of anthem-kneeling Latarsha and Devon, these kids can sit the hell at home while kids with more deserving melanin and fashionable sexual behaviors and failing performances get all the attention from your school district.

Have you chatted with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] about the fact that there are no board members who have the approved black melanin content and the coming repercussions to you three because you don`t? And how about the brown melanin content of the other members of your board? You think that the Latin American, Indian-Pakistani and stylish sexual identity-behavioral categories of your colleagues are going to mollify Devon and Latarsha for long? They`re going to be taking their industrial grade lasers, IEDs and bolt-cutters to your houses next. And as they sit in the middle of a mob outside your house, and scream out that the street in front of your house is THEIR street, and not yours, you remember what you didn`t do to stop their disgusting discrimination. I'm writing to you because I'm very concerned and disturbed, as many others are, about the Fox 32 article titled "SUBURBAN SCHOOL DISTRICT INCLUDES STUDENTS OF COLOR IN GROUPS WITH FIRST CHANCE AT IN-PERSON LEARNING: REPORT.

How does it make sense to combat racism with racism? That is the loud and clear message readers have gotten. Why should there be a separation of races when all races have common issues? White people are being beat up and shamed for being racist. And we've been told only white people are racist. The way this article is written does not encourage a solution. It adds to the problem. In Summary: On 9-1-20 at 1530hrs, I, Det. Henderson*110, was requested to call Dr. Andalib Khelghati (Assistant Superintendent) and take a report in regard to a Disorderly Conduct that had occurred earlier in the day at 1500 McDaniel.

Upon speaking with Khelghati, he advised me of the following: On 9-1-20 at approximately 0900hrs, his colleague, Dr. La Tarsha Green, received an unsettling postcard, addressed to her, in the mail. He stated that the postcard `used threatening language through Bible verses about death` and that Dr. Green felt threatened. He also stated that an Evidence Technician collected said postcard for evidence. Additionally, Khelghati stated that SRO Miller had previously investigated strange letters received at Dist. 65 schools in the past to include: Park, Kingsley and the Early Childhood Center, but was unsure of the dates and listed September, October, or November of 2019 as possibilities. Khelghati continued that he also provided envelopes from those incidents to ET Messing for evidentiary purposes, as he felt as though the handwriting on all three pieces of evidence were `similar` (See ET report for details). Khelghati requested that I follow-up with Green for more details about the postcard incident. He also requested that I contact Dist. 65 Superintendent, Dr. Devon Horton [REDACTED] to provide an update about the case. Khelghati stated that he would be the point of contact for any additional updates going forward.

ET Messing sent me photos of the evidence that was collected. I observed a postcard that read the following:

Front of postcard was a pre-printed photo of a field of flowers with a cross and the words: Jesus We Love Him Because He First Loved Us. 1 John 4:19 (the postcard was not packaged).

Back of postcard:

"Jesus Loves You" (in black ink)
 "Attn: La Tarsha Green" (all other writing in what appeared to be blue ink)
 "Read Hebrews 9:27 in any Bible" (with some words underlined in what appeared to be red ink)

There was not any identifying information about the sender listed on the postcard or on either of the two envelopes collected. It is also unknown if the author(s) is the same for all three pieces of evidence.

Upon researching the above listed scripture, I learned the interpretation (according to the Christian version) to be: "Just as man is

appointed to die once, and after that to face judgment, so also Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many; and He will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who eagerly await Him..."

At 1757hrs, I spoke with Dist. 65 Deputy Superintendent, Dr. Green [REDACTED]. Dr. Green told me the following: A temporary secretary (name unknown) brought her the mail, which included the postcard at 0930hrs on 9-1-20. Dr. Green's office is located in the 1500 McDaniel building. Green stated that she looked up the meaning of the scripture and interpreted it to mean, "It's about Christ in a new role of covenant with humanity where everyone has to die and face consequences or a sacrifice". Green stated that the scripture referred to in the postcard concerned her enough to pass along the information to her supervisors because it was about death rather than something positive. Green stated that she felt as though the postcard was a form of retaliation for an article published 8-7-20 in regard to in-person schooling in Dist. 65 (See 20-6711). I asked Green if she felt threatened and she stated that she did not and simply wanted to make others in the district aware of the postcard. Green stated that she would appreciate a 'Special Watch' for 1500 McDaniel, but did not feel as though one was necessary for her home at this time. Green advised that she lives in Chicago and would contact the Chicago Police Department for any issues to include her residence. I advised that I would complete a special watch request.

I contacted Postal Inspector, Chad Liersch (celiersch@uspis.gov), to inquire as to whether or not the sender and/or an address could be identified/located based on the evidence. I provided my contact information and requested a follow-up. A copy of this report will be provided to Det. Giese and Tortorello to be submitted to the Chicago Police Department Crime Prevention and Information Center as well as Statewide Terrorism and Intelligence Center and the Federal Bureau of Investigation per Sgt. Bush.

At 1830hrs, I contacted and provided an update to Dr. Devon Horton ([REDACTED]) and Dr. Khelghati ([REDACTED]).

On the above date and time, I, Officer Messing #228, responded to 1500 McDaniel, School District 65 administration building, in reference to a call of a disorderly conduct-harassment. Upon arrival, I spoke with the caller, [REDACTED] who was the executive assistant to the Superintendent. [REDACTED] stated on 09/14/2020 at approximately 0900 hours, Superintendent Dr. Devon Horton received a post card addressed to him with the administration office address (1500 McDaniel). Said post card had a picture of a floral meadow with a religious cross on the front, with the words, "Jesus. We love him because he first loved us" 1JOHN4:19.

On the reverse side of the post card was written:

"GOD LOVES YOU", and "Attn: Devon Horton, Read Hebrews 9:27 in the Bible"

[REDACTED] stated this Bible verse is threatening in nature and Dr. Horton views it as a form of harassment. [REDACTED] stated this was a reoccurring incident, and the same post card was sent to Dr. Green, Assistant Superintendent, a couple weeks ago. Reference 20-007468 for further. Said post card was collected and turned over to E.T. Bernhardt for further processing. Said post was touched by several employees before being turned over to me. After looking up the above Bible verse it reads:

"It is appointed for men once to die, and after this the judgment".

No offender information available. No further information.

District 65 Superintendent Devon Green told me there was a voicemail that was received from the business line on 07/02/21 that has since been deleted. District 65 Superintendent Devon Green said District 65 has been in contact with IT to attempt to recover the voicemail.

I was informed the voicemail stated "If Martin Luther King was alive he would come out of his grave and slash your black ass. Enjoy the lawsuit cocksuckers". I received a document indicating the voicemail was from telephone number [REDACTED] which is listed as associated with [REDACTED]. The document was scanned and placed into evidence.com.

The second voicemail was received on 07/08/21 and was recorded to a USB drive.

The second voicemail stated: "I don't know what is wrong with you racist demons that are pissing all over the grave of Martin Luther King Jr

Next I spoke to social worker [REDACTED] learned of [REDACTED] call and contacted [REDACTED] for further details. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED], the questions [REDACTED] asked were too personal. [REDACTED] feared she could be victimized in some way if the information was available. [REDACTED] assured [REDACTED] the questions were necessary and the data would be secure. [REDACTED] offered to delete the information. [REDACTED] did not want the information deleted because she wanted her children enrolled in the school. [REDACTED] then became upset and told [REDACTED] she feared the information she provided the school would be used to traffic her sons. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED], "if my kids go missing, someone there will go missing." [REDACTED] ended the conversation.

[REDACTED] and her sons must return to the school to be evaluated.
